  - a. Books except those for use in Tariff Classification Exercises and notes, review materials, other printed materials containing data/information/formula.
  - b. PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS
  - or similar c. CELLULAR PHONES, beepers, portable computers gadgets/devices.
  - d. Bags of any kinds (ladies bag and shoulder bags, attaché case, backpacks, etc.)
  - e. Other examination aides not stated on this program.
